The UK, Britain, Great Britain, The British Isles, England.... What's the difference?

The UK is short for The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland(大 不列顛與北愛爾蘭聯合王國). It is a sovereign state (in the same way as France or the USA) but is made up of four countries; England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. For Americans, the best analogy would be that the UK is like the USA, whilst its four consistent countries are like states.
